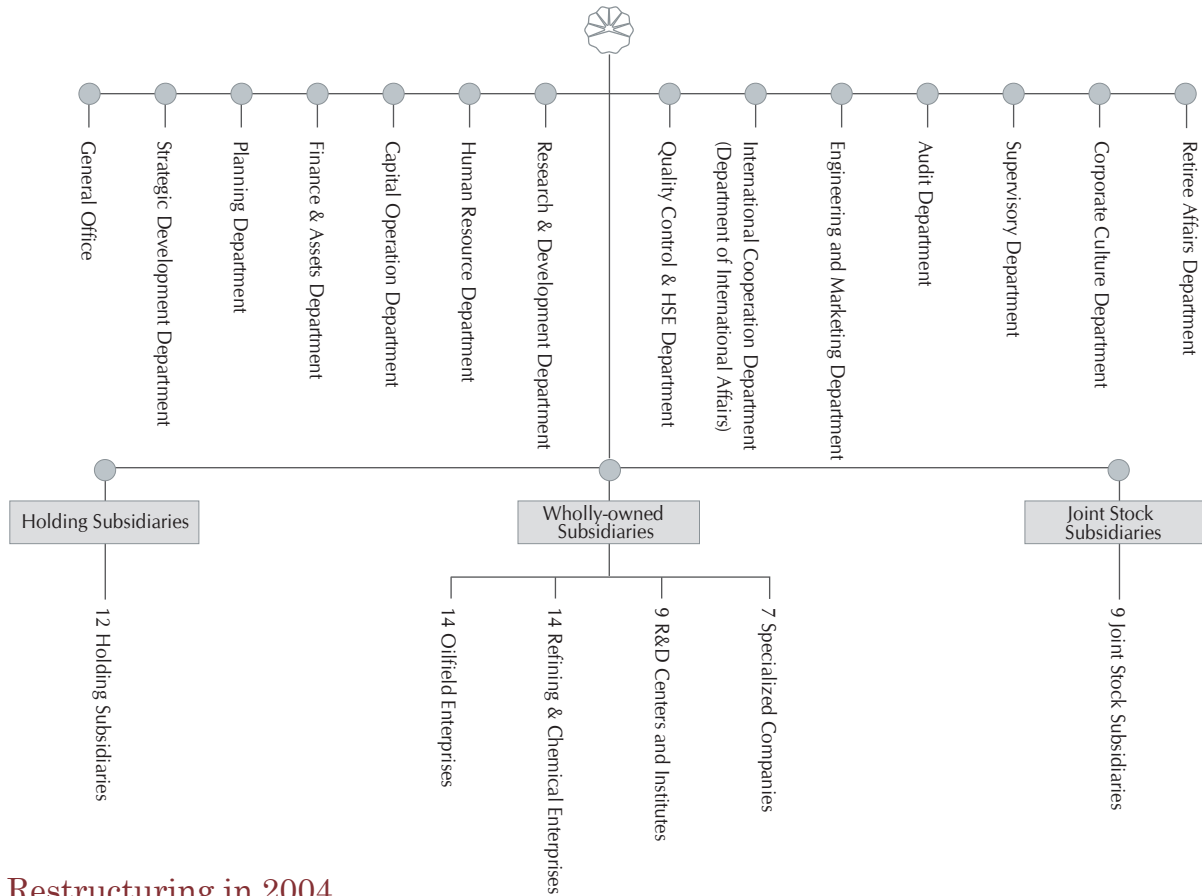

## Restructuring in 2004

On August 11 ■ CNPC West Pipeline Co., Ltd. was incorporated with joint financial contribution from 8 enterprises including CNPC, PetroChina, Daqing Petroleum Administration, Xinjiang Petroleum Administration, China Petroleum Pipeline Bureau, Changqing Petroleum Exploration Bureau, Tuha Petroleum Exploration and Development Headquarters and Tarim Petroleum Exploration and Development Headquarters. CNPC West Pipeline Co., Ltd. has a registered capital of 8 billion yuan, with offices in Urumqi of Xinjiang Auto. Reg. Its main business scope covers storage, transportation and sales of crude oil and oil products, the development, promotion and application of petroleum storage and transportation technology, as well as the construction of and consultation on petroleum storage and transportation engineering projects.

On August 13 ■ The Tarim Petroleum and Petrochemical Engineering Construction Headquarters and the Tarim Petroleum Exploration and Development Headquarters were reorganized and renamed the Tarim Oilfield Service Company.

On August 17 ■ CNPC organized its Engineering and Marketing Department on the previous Marketing Management Department.

On October 15 ■ China Petroleum Offshore Engineering Ltd. was incorporated with investment from 3 enterprises including CNPC, Liaohe Petroleum Exploration Bureau, PetroChina Dagang Oilfield Company, with registered capital of one billion yuan and offices in Beijing. Its main business scope covers offshore petroleum drilling and exploration technology, R&D and design of offshore petroleum engineering, offshore drilling, downhole operation, well testing and recovery engineering, offshore engineering construction, installation, service and maintenance, offshore oil and gas operations vessel service, the design, manufacturing, maintenance and repair of relevant equipment, as well as associated business.

On November 2 ■ Ningxia Dayuan Refining and Chemicals Co., Ltd. and Qingyang Refining and Chemicals Co., Ltd. were incorporated into PetroChina.
